At Pollyteach Forest School, we aim to create the right learning environment by supporting our community to build confidence, raise self-esteem, develop social skills and character, encourage questioning, have a developed moral compass, build resilience and recognise the importance of their well-being and the well-being of others.

We aim to enable students to experience challenge, succeed in their learning, and feel that learning can be fun and relevant to their lives, and to become independent and enthusiastic learners with a willingness to take considered risks.

SESSION DETAILS

Sessions are available in two slots: 9:30-12:00 and 12:30-15:00, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Sessions are available for up to 8 students and would require school staff to accompany the group in a safe ratio determined by the school/referrer.

Sessions are £315 plus VAT per session as a flat fee and are available to book in blocks of 6 or 12 weeks. Two Forest School qualified Pollyteach staff will lead the session, making it safe for medium sized groups, and transport support is available upon enquiry.
